



# Stories Along The KHT Corridor

*Knobstone Trail, Thru Hiked—Nov. 24-28 2019*

*I live in Oklahoma now, but I grew up in Floyds Knobs. I paid \$60 for the younger Mr. Campbell to shuttle me from Deam Lake to Delaney Park at dusk on Sunday 11/24. I walked less than a mile to the first hill and camped overnight. I carried too much water (4 quarts) because the web page is scary, but in reality almost all creeks were flowing and there were many, many unmarked water stashes all along the trail. I camped near mile 34 between SP56 and Elk Creek 11/25-26, near mile 21 next to the creek 11/26-27, and near mile 5 at the top of the hollow 11/27-28. Someone got out of their house at dawn and started shooting bullets across the hollow on Thanksgiving morning. I yelled, but the shooting continued. I cleaned up camp quickly with no breakfast, hiked the last 5 miles, and made it to my brother's Thanksgiving dinner on time*
